KEYNOTE

Raj Patel

“Is this What Democracy Looks Like? A Tale of Two Seattles”



Raj Patel will honor CAGJ's 20th Anniversary, linking our roots in the 1999 Seattle uprising against the World Trade Organization to our collective struggle today for Food Sovereignty. Patel is an award-winning writer, activist, and academic. He is the author of several books including *Stuffed and Starved: The Hidden Battle for the World Food System*, and *Inflamed: Deep Medicine and the*

Anatomy of Injustice, co-authored with Rupa Marya, in addition to the foreword to CAGJ's book, *Our Food, Our Right: Recipes for Food Justice*. He has testified about the causes of hunger to the US, EU and UK governments, and is a member of the International Panel of Experts on Sustainable Food

Systems. He recently released his documentary film, *The Ants and the Grasshopper*, and he can be heard with Tom Philpott and Rebecca McNroy co-hosting *The Secret Ingredient* podcast.
